The aim of the workshop is to bring together female academic researchers to promote and exchange ideas in the fields of Macroeconomics, Law and Economics, and Economic History. The conference will facilitate and support the formation of professional networks among female economists.

The 1st ECONtribute Workshop for Women in Macroeconomics, Law and Economics and Economic History is organized by the ECONtribute Cluster of Excellence and the University of Bonn. This two-day workshop will be held in person at the Universitätsclub Bonn, Germany on June 19-20, 2023.

Each conference day will include a keynote lecture as well as sessions with contributed papers and discussions. One keynote lecture will be delivered by **Christine Binzel (FAU Erlangen/Nürnberg)**. Invited speakers will also share some of their experiences and insights of pursuing a career in their field.

We invite empirical as well as experimental contributions from a broad range of topics within Macroeconomics, Law and Economics, Economic History, and related fields, including, but not limited to:

- Social and wealth inequality
- Legal frameworks and behavioral finance
- Current and historical development of institutions and cultural norms
- Distributional effects of (macroeconomic) policies and legal rules
- Macroeconomic implications of climate change
