Press release: Rapid tests effectively contained Covid-19 I Hans-Martin von Gaudecker

Rapid tests effectively broke Covid-19 infection chains in spring 2021, while vaccinations played only a minor role. This is shown by a new model developed by cluster member Hans-Martin von Gaudecker and his colleagues. According to the simulation, rapid tests reduced the number of infections in Germany by more than 40 percent in May alone.

Press release: Social norms influence willingness to protect the climate I Peter Andre, Teodora Boneva, Felix Chopra & Armin Falk

People contribute only very little to climate protection, because they underestimate the willingness of others to contribute. This is the central result of a new study by cluster members Peter Andre, Teodora Boneva, Felix Chopra and Armin Falk. The results are based on an extensive survey experiment in the U.S.
